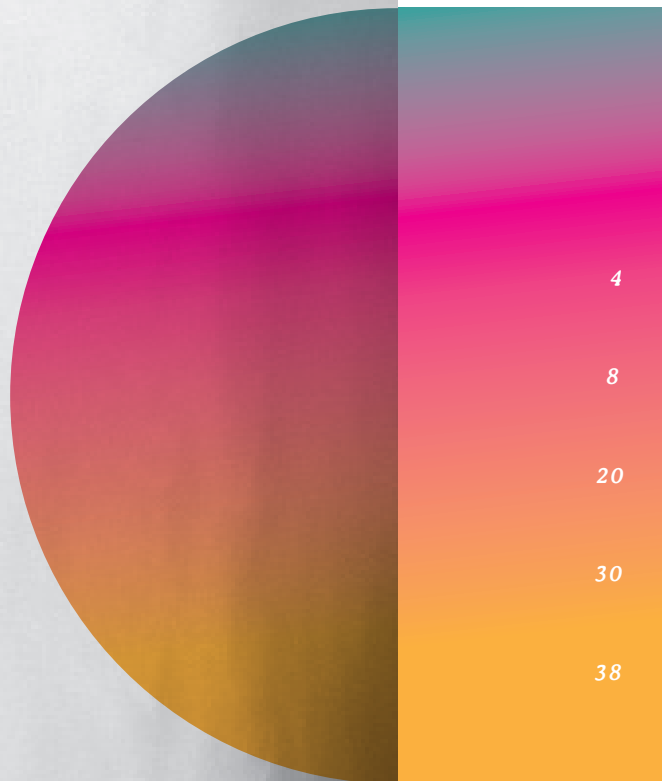

We see it taking shape day after day—a holy temple built by God, all of us built into it, a temple in which God is quite at home."
